The UGA Workforce Education program offers a wide range of graduate degrees designed to help CTAE educators to think and address 21st century work preparation. The UGA Workforce Education program was ranked the Number 1 graduate technical/vocational program in the country by *US News & World Report*. Through our graduate degrees, students are able to increase and/or update knowledge and skills, maintain certification requirements, pursue professional development or prepare for leadership opportunities.

All of our graduate degrees are 100% PSC approved for either initial certification and/or advanced program certification (Masters, Specialist, Doctorate).

The following CTAE areas fall under the approved PSC programs:

Our degree options include:

- **ONLINE MED** – Master's of Education in Workforce Education – 100% online (admitting students in all academic terms, application deadlines: Spring semester – November 15; Summer term – May 1; Fall term – July 1)
 - **MED** – Master's of Education in Workforce Education – 75% Online/Hybrid-Griffin – using a blend of face-to-face & online learning (admitting students in all academic terms, application deadlines: Spring semester – November 15; Summer term – May 1; Fall term – July 1)
 - **MAT** – *Master's of Arts in Teaching* – geared to those individuals who need initial certification (admitting students in all academic terms, application deadlines: Spring semester – November 15; Summer term – May 1; Fall term – July 1)
 - **EDS** – *Specialist in Education* – 75% Online/Hybrid-Griffin – using a blend of face-to-face & online learning; Beyond the masters but without the heavy emphasis on research (admitting students in all academic terms, application deadlines: Spring semester – November 15; Summer term – May 1; Fall term – July 1)
 - **Edd** – *Doctor of Education* (Athens) – prepares individuals for leadership and other roles in CTAE (application deadline is March 15, 2014)
- **Edd** – *Doctor of Education* (75% Online/Hybrid-Griffin) – a blend of face-to-face & online learning (next cohort group beginning Fall 2014, application deadline **April 15, 2014**)
- **PHD** – *Doctor of Philosophy* (Athens) – career preparation where research & scholarship are central activities (application deadline is March 15, 2014)
